

Arrival & Departure

- Class Begins at 8:00am
 - · Students may be dropped off after 7:30am
 - · Students go directly to their classrooms upon arrival
- Elementary School dismisses at 2:25pm
 - · Car riders wait in the Gym
 - · Bus riders wait in the Gym
 - · After school care students are walked directly to after school staff

Car Rider Procedures

Morning

- -Enter drive between Hursey's & Car Wash
- -Single lane of traffic
- -Pull forward as far as possible before letting student out
- -Staff will assist students-parents need to remain in the car
- -Students should be dropped off in the car line-parents do not need to park & walk them in
- -Helpful Hint: The best time to arrive is between 7:30-7:45am

Afternoon

- -Enter drive between Hursey's & Car Wash
- -Double lane of traffic-Kindergarten parents remain in the inside lane
- -Place student name in windshield
- -Staff will assist students-parents need to remain in the car
- -Students must be picked up in the car line-parents may not park & walk in to pick the students up
- -Helpful Hint: The best time to pick up is between 2:45-2:55pm
